Nightly Challenge

Sunday Music: Highlight today's scripture in your Bible. Go to www.faithink.com and listen to the song by entering **TC08** in the FINKlink box on the bottom left. What words or phrases jump out at you? Why?

Monday Art Encounter: What do you see in the image on the front page? How might it relate to lies?

Tuesday Catechism Encounter: Open your Small Catechism or go online to Part I: The Ten Commandments. Hold hands and whisper, "I will not lie!" three times. Shout it together three times. Whisper it again three times. Now read Luther's explanation of the Eighth Commandment. What words or phrases jump out at you? Why?

Wednesday Game Night: Go to www.faithink.com and play the Quizbowl game by entering **TC08** in the FINKlink box on the bottom left column. Scroll to the bottom of the linked page and click "Launch Game." Have fun!

Thursday Question: Think about a time when someone told a lie about you. What did that person take from you by doing that? What did they gain? What did they lose? Why did they do it? How did you respond? What would you do differently if that situation had been reversed?

Friday Role Play: Act out one of these situations.

1. A teacher gave you a higher grade than you deserved on a test. You approach her desk. What do you do? What do you say?
2. A friend is spreading rumors about another friend. You know the rumors are false. What do you do and say?
